Competition rules

- 1. Anglers must have currant freshwater permits & must comply with all fisheries & boating guidelines
 - All freshwater permits must be presented when signing in.
- 2. Fishing is not permitted within defined non-boating or non-fishing areas. Fishing is restricted to the dam only, fishing off the dam banks will be permitted within sight of team member & team boat .team members must fish out of the same boat.
- 3. A team will consist of & a maximum of two persons a team may have a skipper but must pay a \$20 donation to Variety Children's Charity.
- 4. Canoes: will be allowed either as a team of 2 single seaters or one 2 seater, single seat canoes have to be within sight of each other at all times.
- 5. No other persons are allowed into the vessel other than fully paid entrants (the only exception will be camera crew or official photographers that have being approval by the tournament organisers, or tournament Marshalls.
- 6. This is a catch and release competition only. All species of fish must be release alive as quickly as possible.
- 7. No burley of any form is to be used.
- 8. Only artificial flies to be used only.
- 9. Only one fly rod in use at any time per angler.
- 10. The tournament is open to all line classes.
- 11. No gaffs to be used to capture fish.
- All decisions made by the tournament organiser's concerning rules, prizes & trophies are final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- 13. Tournament Marshalls may be allowed to check entrant's compliance with rules at any time while tournament under way
- 14. Tournament Organisers reserve the right to disqualify anyone acting in such away as to cause concern for safety of all entrants & public alike, or for a manner which is in conflict with the rules of the competition.
